Who is hosting the lions visit?

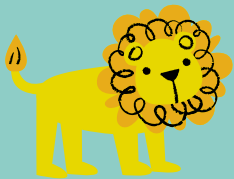
- Cheltenham and Gloucester Hospitals Charity - the local charity that helps our local hospitals do even more.
